Your graduation is your responsibility. This plan is unofficial. Your degree audit is the official record used by the Graduation Office to determine graduation eligibility. Run a new degree audit every time you register for your semester. Courses that are dropped, failed, or repeated may change your estimated graduation term. Repeated courses count for credit once. The most recent course grade counts, not the course with the highest grade. For courses repeated at UofU and another college, it is always the UofU course that counts for credit. You must earn a C- or better for a course to count towards your major.
